



1. Introduction

Introducing the Yak Delay: Unleash the Beast of Delays! Safari Pedals presents a wild, extreme, and highly effective delay plugin in collaboration with Dan Mayo.

With its enigmatic "Random" knob, twist the high and low pass filters for your desired mixture. The blend and output knobs create anything from a filtered delay to a super hifi ping pong sound. Get ready to embark on a sonic adventure. Give it a try and let the madness begin! ;)



2. Installation

Installation For Mac users:

The included installer should install the plugin's VST3, AU, and AAX formats automatically, you may need to restart your DAW to see the plugin listed.

For Windows users:

You will have to manually move the plugin formats into their respective folders. Common locations for each format are as follows: VST3: C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3 AAX: C:\Program Files\Common Files\Avid\Audio\Plug-Ins If after restarting your DAW, you still don't see the plugin listed, check your DAW's plugin folder settings, and be sure that the plugin is in the proper location for your software.

3. Product registration

When launching the Yak Delay for the first time, you will see the serial registration screen, and if you have not yet purchased a license, here is where you can begin your trial period. If purchased, enter your license key for the product and click the submit button to start getting wild

During trial mode you can still register at any time by clicking the Safari logo in the top left, and opening the registration prompt from there. After your trial ends you will go back to seeing the registration prompt every time you open an instance, and you will have to register the product to continue.

4. Features

The Drive button is where you can get saucy! This is pre delay So it can get super creative! You can turn it on and off with the red button



The "Time" knob will control the time of the repeats. It can be either set to ms, or to sync to your daw's session. Double click the number on the ms settings in order to enter a specific number



The ping-pong feature in the Yak delay is unique in that you can control it's width From 0% (mono) all the way up to 100% (full stereo)



4. Features

Each knob has a nice little red button next to it! If you click it it turns that Process off. This means you can even use the delay as a drive or filter!




The blend knob allows you to blend the drive to taste With the dry signal
