1. Introduction

Introducing the "Lion Master" by Safari Pedals, a groundbreaking audio plugin meticulously crafted from the ground up. 2. Installation

Installation For Mac users:

The included installer should install the plugin's VST3, AU, and AAX formats automatically, you may need to restart your DAW to see the plugin listed.

For Windows users:

You will have to manually move the plugin formats into their respective folders. Common locations for each format are as follows: VST3: C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3 AAX: C:\Program Files\Common Files\Avid\Audio\Plug-Ins If after restarting your DAW, you still don't see the plugin listed, check your DAW's plugin folder settings, and be sure that the plugin is in the proper location for your software.

3. Product registration

When launching the Lion Master for the first time, you will see the serial registration screen, and if you have not yet purchased a license, here is where you can begin your trial period. If purchased, enter your license key for the product and click the submit button to start getting wild

During trial mode you can still register at any time by clicking the Safari logo in the top left, and opening the registration prompt from there. After your trial ends you will go back to seeing the registration prompt every time you open an instance, and you will have to register the product to continue.

4. Features

Input gain will control the amount of gain you would like to add to the input signal



A true peak limiter is a inf ratio limiter that uses oversampling to control inter sample peaks. With the Lion Master you can choose to turn it on or off



The “LF Gain” and “HF Gain” knobs control the amount of gain Of each side of the spectrum in to the limiter. You can choose where the line between Them is by moving the “cross over” knob on the bottom left



4. Features

The CrossOver knob controls the split between the two “Low Energy” and “High Energy” knobs control the amount of gain Of each side of the spectrum in to the limiter.



The width control will make your sides lower, But notice it has a little magic eq Going as well. Be gentle with it but enjoy that sauce ;)



The output knob enables you to choose the output level. Based on if the “true peak” knob is on or off it will react differently.



4. Features

Selecting the G.R feature on the output meter will show you the amount of gain Reduction from the limiter

Use the preset library to store, delete and use your favorite presets!
