1. Introduction

Meet 'Camel Strip' by Safari Pedals, a vintage-flavored channel strip that infuses your audio with desert vibes. Camel Strip begins with 'Input Drive' that introduces slight color and character to your sound.

The EQ section, with its trio of handy knobs - low, mid, and high gain, lets you shape your sound without getting lost in the process.

The 'Gate' and 'Compressor' sections bring simplicity to your mix. With just one knob, your sound is dialed in.

Simply put, Camel Strip is your dessert shaping tool packaged in an easy-to-navigate Safari Pedal.



2. Installation

Installation For Mac users:

The included installer should install the plugin's VST3, AU, and AAX formats automatically, you may need to restart your DAW to see the plugin listed.

For Windows users:

You will have to manually move the plugin formats into their respective folders. Common locations for each format are as follows:

- VST3: C:\Program Files\Common Files\VST3
- AAX: C:\Program Files\Common Files\Avid\Audio\Plug-Ins

If after restarting your DAW, you still don't see the plugin listed, check your DAW's plugin folder settings, and be sure that the plugin is in the proper location for your software.

3. Product registration

When launching the Camel Strip for the first time, you will see the serial registration screen, and if you have not yet purchased a license, here is where you can begin your trial period. If purchased, enter your license key for the product and click the submit button to start getting wild

During trial mode you can still register at any time by clicking the serial number prompt, and opening the registration prompt from there. After your trial ends you will go back to seeing the registration prompt every time you open an instance, and you will have to register the product to continue.

4. Features

Remember: Double clicking + pressing command will restore the default settings of any selected knob

Input Drive: Start by dialing in the perfect amount of color and saturation to your sound.



EQ Section: Choose from three types of EQ (EQ1A, 73, and 4k). With low, mid, and high gain knobs.

Remember: Double clicking + pressing command will restore the default settings of any selected knob

Gate section: Threshold-controlled gate effect with hard or soft knee. This single knob control ensures you get your sound dial with ease.



Compressor Section: Select from FAIR, 2A, or 76 types of compressors. With one knob.



4. Features

Remember: Double clicking + pressing command will restore the default settings of any selected knob

FX section: Select between the Plate and Chorus to add an extra dimension to your sound. You can control their intensity with the ease of a single knob.



Width: The Width feature will enable you to widen the affected sound without changing the mono signal

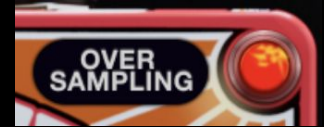

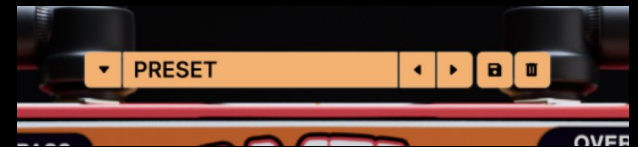
4. Features

Over-Sampling: This savvy little button is your ticket to avoid aliasing
But remember, sound is a wild beast and sometimes, over-sampling might not be its favorite treat.

Trust your ears and let them guide you on this one - they're the best jungle guides you've got!"

All LEDs can turn on/off any of the plugin's features individually
