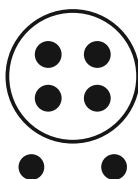

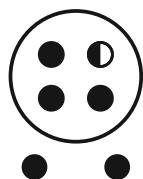
HOW TO READ The four holes in the circle are on the front. The two lower holes are thumb holes on the back.

● Covered ○ Open ◐ Half-cover

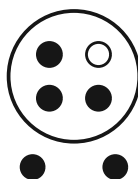
