Precautions

Power Supply

Please connect the designated power cable to an AC outlet of the correct voltage.

Unplug the power cable when not using or during electrical storms.

Connections

Always turn off the power of this and all other equipment before connecting or disconnecting, this will help prevent malfunction and / or damage to other devices. Also make sure to disconnect all connection cables and the power cord before moving this unit.

Location

To avoid deformation, discoloration, or other serious damage, do not expose this unit to the following conditions:

- Direct sunlight
- Heat sources
- Magnetic fields
- Extreme temperature or humidity
- Excessive dusty or dirty location
- High humidity or moisture
- Strong vibration or shock

Interference with other electrical devices

Radios and televisions placed nearby may experience reception interference. Operate this unit at a suitable distance from radios and televisions.

Cleaning

Clean only with a soft, dry cloth. If necessary, slightly moisten the cloth. Do not use abrasive cleanser, cleaning alcohol, paint thinners, wax, solvents, cleaning fluids, or chemical-impregnated wiping cloths.

Handling

Do not apply excessive force to the switches or controls. Do not let paper, metallic, or other objects into this unit. Take care not to drop the unit, and do not subject it to shock or excessive pressure.

Before Using


Please make sure the tubes are all still installed firmly before using Little Monster BM, in case they get loose during transportation.


Connections



Warning: Always keep all the knobs at minimum while connecting guitar and speakers.

Panel Instruction

Front Panel



POWER Switch and LED: Turn on or turn off the gear, LED indicates the status.


Warning: Always connect Speaker Out to the cabinet with a speaker cable before turn on the power.

- **VOLUME Knob:** Adjust the master volume of the amplifier.
- 03 GAIN Knob: Adjust the gain of the amplifier.
- **Tone Switch:** Switch between THIN mode and MELLOW mode. THIN - A bit more bright and shining sound. MELLOW - A little plump and fat sound.
- **Channel Switch:** Switch between NORMAL channel and BRIGHT channel.

NORMAL - Basic characteristic sound of Little Monster BM. BRIGHT - More gain will be obtained in this channel and the high band frequency will be increased a little bit.

06 INPUT Jack: 1/4" mono audio jack, for connecting the guitar.

Rear Panel



01 SPEAKER OUT Jack: Connect to the cabinet (speaker).

Warning: Never switch the amplifier on without a loudspeaker connected.

02 8Ω/16Ω Selector: Choose the output impedance corresponding to the speaker.

Warning: Always ensure the extension cabinet used is of the correct impedance

Power Input: For connecting electricity here with the supplied power cable.


Warning: Always use the supplied power cord, if a replacement is required, please contact your authorized dealer.

Fuse: Protects the amplifier from electrical fault.

Warning: Never attempt to bypass the fuse or replace it of incorrect values.

Tube Replacement

Use the accessorial wrench to unlock all the bolts and take down the metal cover.



Warning: Before replacing tubes, the power must be turned off.

Warning: Vacuum tubes will get very hot during working, please make sure they are cooling before replacing, in case of getting scalded.

Fuse Replacement



The Fuse provides amplifier circuit protection, please read carefully before you replaced it.

Warning: Always replace a fuse with one of the specific rating and type as printed on the fuse holder. Never install a fuse of a higher rating than the value printed on the back of your amplifier and Specifications.

Warning: Always turn off the power before replacing fuse.
