



Play The Piano

1. Using DC Power Jack

Connection for the included DC power adapter. Please use only the provided adapter.

2. Standby/On

Press the [STANDBY/ON] button to turn on the power and the LED display will illuminate.


STANDBAON

Auto Standby

Your piano will switch off automatically after 30 minutes of inactivity. In this case, press the [STANDBY/ON] button to turn on the power.


Deactivate Auto Standby Function

To deactivate the Auto Standby Function: hold the first white key and first black key from the left side of the keyboard at the same time and then press the [STANDBY/ON] button.



3.Adjusting Volume

You can use the [MASTER VOLUME] knob to adjust the volume.



4. Using Headphone


Two sets of standard stereo headphones can be plugged in here for private practice or late-night playing. The internal speaker system is automatically shut off when a pair of headphones is plugged into PHONES jacks.



5. Using LINE IN And LINE OUT Jack

The audio output from other sound system connected to the LINE IN jack on the bottom panel can be mixed with the sound of the unit. This function is convenient when you want to play along with a favourite song.

The Line Out jack can be used to deliver the output of the piano to a keyboard amplifier, stereo sound system, mixing console or tape recorder.



6. Using USB TO HOST Jack

This product allows the transfer of MIDI information over USB to a computer. Complicated as it sounds, it's pretty simple. Because your piano is USB Class Compliant, there is no need to install a driver to enable it to work with OSX, Windows XP, Vista or Windows 7 and so on .Just plug it in and the OS will do the rest. The piano will work with all standard MIDI based computer software.

USB AUDIO interface is a digital audio interface. By USB cable, you can digitally transfer intact audio signals of PC to this instrument, and enjoy it on this instrument or use it for accompany when you play this instrument; likewise, you can transfer intact audio signals of the instrument to PC to record and edit music.

7. Using MIDI OUT Jack

MIDI (Musical Instrument Digital Interface) is a world-standard communication interface which allows electronic musical instruments to communicate with eachother, by sending and receiving compatible notes, program changes and other types of MIDI data. You should only plug the MIDI out in to another device featuring a MIDI input.




Sustain

8. Piano Pedal

a.Sustain Pedal(supplied)

The foot pedal included with your digital piano will cause piano key sounds to decay slowly as if they were being held down. A piano-style pedal may optionally be used. The jack will auto-detect the polarity of the sustain pedal.



b.Double Pedal(optional)

This digital piano can be used with a Double pedal.

Soft Pedal(left): The Soft Pedal controls the sound volume. Press

the pedal to decrease the output sound volume.

Sustain(right): It performs the same function as the damper pedal

on an actual acoustic piano, letting you sustain the Soft

sound of the voices even after releasing your fingers

from the keys.


The jack will auto-detect the polarity of the pedal.

9. Voices

The piano has 16 built-in voices which include several pianos as well as other instruments. To select a voice (Main voice), press the appropriate Voice Select button on the right side of the front panel.

Press [BANK] button and the indicator is light, then press voice buttons to select the voice in the second line.

You can also use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select voice.



10. Touch Sensitivity

Press [TOUCH] button repeatedly, you can select four type of touch sensitivity styles to accommodate your play and the button indicator will light.

LOW style: require more strength to produce maximal sound.

NORMAL style: require standard strength to produce maximal sound.


HIGH style: require less strength to produce maximal sound.

FIXED style: when touch is off, the same volume is produced no matter how strongly or softly you play the keyboard.




11.Metronome

Press the [METRONOME] button, you can turn on or off metronome function. When this function is on, you can select speed by [DATA CONTROL] knob, range(20-280). If 5 seconds do not work, the screen will return to the voice interface.




Press and hold the [METRONOME] button until the LED display: 4.4, then release the button and use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select beat type (2.2,2.4,3.4,4.4,5.4,6.8,7.8,9.8,12.8).



12. Transpose

The Transpose function will raise or lower the pitch of the keyboard in semitone increments from -12 to +12.


To turn Transpose on, press the [TRANS] button. The LED will display: 0. Now use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select the desired transpose value.



13. Demo Play

There are 16 demo songs pre-recorded in the piano. Each demo song will demonstrate a different voice. Here's how you can select and play the demo songs.

Press the [METRONOME] and [TRANS] buttons at the same time to play or stop the demo song. Use the voice select buttons and the [BANK] button to select songs.




14. Reverb Effect

The Reverb effect may be applied to each voice individually and will be retained even when the power is turned off.

Press [REVERB] button to open or close the reverb function, the LED will display: r-1. Use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to adjust the reverb type (r-1 \sim r-8).

To adjust the amount (depth) of the reverb effect, press and hold down the [REVERB] button about 3 seconds, then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to adjust the desired amount (0-127).





15. Chorus Effect

The Chorus effect may be applied to each voice individually and will be retained even when the power is turned off.

Press [CHORUS] button to open or close the chorus function, the LED will display: c-1. Use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to adjust the chorus type (c-1 \sim c-8).

To adjust the amount (depth) of the chorus effect, Press and hold down the [CHORUS] button about 3 seconds, then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to adjust the desired amount (0-127).




16. EQ Mode

Press [REVERB] and [CHORUS] buttons at the same time to enter EQ mode.


a. Change the Value of EQ Bass

Press [REVERB] button, the LED display the value of EQ bass, then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to adjust the value, range $(-12\sim12)$.



b. Change the Value of EQ Treble

Press [CHORUS] button, the LED display the value of EQ treble, then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to adjust the value, range $(-12\sim12)$.



17. Split Mode

Press [SPLIT] button to enter split mode, your keyboard will be divided into two sections, which means different voices can be played with the left and right hands at the same time.

a. Enter Split Mode

Press the [SPLIT] button and the Split indicator will light. The LED will show: SPL.

The Split (left hand) voice will be E.PIANO and the Split Point will be F2.








b. Change the Split Voice

Hold down [SPLIT] button, then press the voice button to select the Split voice.












c. Change the Split Point

Press and hold down [SPLIT] button, then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select the Split Point .





d. Exit the Split Mode

Press [SPLIT] button again to exit the Split mode.

18. Dual Mode


Press [DUAL] button to enter Dual voice mode, two voices will sound simultaneously when you play keyboards.





a. Select Dual Voice

Hold down [DUAL] button, then press the voice button to select the Dual voice.



b. Exit The Dual Mode

Press [DUAL] button again to exit the Dual mode.






19. Duet Mode

With the duet feature engaged the keyboard is divided into two sections that play the same notes.

Press [SPLIT] and [DUAL] buttons at the same time to open or close the duet function.





20. Song Recording

The Song Recorder built into the piano can record two individual tracks, allowing you to record one part and then record a second, complementary part while the first part is being played back.

a. To Record a Track

Press the [TRACK] button and the [PLAY] button simultaneously to enter Record Wait Mode. The Metronome will begin playing at the currently selected tempo. The LED display will show: rEC. for one second, after which it will show: tr1.






Now, begin recording.

Press the [TRACK] button to end recording.


b. To Manually Select a Track to Record to:

Press the [TRACK] button, then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select between track1 and track2.

Press the [TRACK] button and the [PLAY] button simultaneously to begin recording. If either of the tracks contains recorded data, the display will show a dot "." in the bottom right hand corner: tr1, tr2.










c. To Erase a Single Track in the Song Recorder:

Press the [TRACK] button then use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select the track you wish to erase.





Press the [TRACK] button twice quickly. The track will be erased, and the piano will be back in Performance Mode.





d. To Play Back Your Song Recorder Tracks:

From Performance Mode, press the [TRACK] button to enter Song Play Mode.





Use the [DATA CONTROL] knob to select one of the following:

SNG: Playback of both of the Song Recorder tracks simultaneously.

TR1: Playback of Song Recorder track 1. TR2: Playback of Song Recorder track 2.

Press the [PLAY] button to start playback.

NOTE -

If there is nothing recorded on either of the tracks (1 or 2), then the Song will not play.

Rather, the Song LED will flash 3 times quickly, and the piano will exit Song Play Mode and resume Performance Mode, with the LED display showing the currently selected voice.

e. To Stop Playback and Exit Song Play Mode:

Press the [PLAY] button again. Song playback will stop, and the piano will exit Song Play Mode and resume Performance Mode with the LED display showing the currently selected voice.

Factory Reset

Performing a Factory Reset will clear all battery backed memory and restore all functions to factory defaults. Please note that anything you have recorded in the Song Recorder will be erased by this procedure!







- Hold down the [METRONOME] and [TRANS] buttons at the same time.
- Turn the Power On.
- The piano will return to Performance Mode (ready-to-play). All button LEDs will return to their default state.
