Make sure that the ground where you assemble your **RockStand®** Guitar Rack Stand is absolutely level and stable. Never use the stand on uneven surfaces or on surfaces which will not support its weight equally under each leg. Ensure that all screws are securely tightened before use.

Instructions:

- Remove the stand carefully from its packaging
- Place the stand on a flat and dry surface
- Unfold the stand completely
- Place the instruments one after the other on the stand, the instrument body must rest equally on the front an rear end of the stand
- The instrument neck must rest between two supports on the neck support













Security Guidelines:

- The instrument body must be rounded in the lower region (see examples above)
- Never move the stand while stocked with instruments
- Keep children from playing with the stand away
- Never use the stand as a ladder or stand for other things
- Place the stand on flat and even surfaces. If the stand is not unfolded as described in the manual, it may tip over

- The stand has been tested in conjunction with various instrument surfaces and lacquers. No problems were identified. Use a dry cloth to clean the product. In the case of hard-working screws, use some oil spray or grease. Please regularly check the firmness of the screws and tighten them, if they should have loosened.
