Philosopher Bass Compressor - Users Guide

Welcome to the realm of Pigtronix! Your new Philosopher Bass Compressor is an analog, optical compressor, sustainer and distortion designed to impart blendable compression, unbelievable sustain and vintage flavored overdrive (when the GRIT is used) to your instrument's tone. The Philosopher Bass Compressor features true bypass switching.

The VOLUME control sets the overall output level. The SUSTAIN control determines the threshold at which the compressor begins to kick in. Lower SUSTAIN settings will give a more transparent, studio type compression, while higher SUSTAIN settings will impart a more noticeable "squashy" sound with additional sonic power and sustain on tap. The BLEND knob determines the mix between the compression signal and the direct signal. With the BLEND fully clockwise, you get 100% compression. With the BLEND set at 12-o'clock, you get 50% compressed signal and 50% direct signal. By mixing in the direct signal with the compressed signal, you are able to restore natural note attack while also enjoying the phenomenal compression sounds of the Philosopher Bass Compressor.

The "GRIT" switch adds in a layer of warm and wooly overdrive sound inspired by Jack Bruce.

The 18VDC power supply that is included provides a huge amount of headroom and output level. With this pedal and compressors in general, more headroom = better tone. Feel free to experiment with running this pedal on a standard 9VDC (neg. tip) supply to get a somewhat different sound, at the expense of headroom and overall output.

DC Power - The Philosopher Bass Compressor comes with an 18VDC, neg. tip power supply. It will also work just fine on a standard Boss style 9VDC power supply. The Philosopher Bass Compressor does not take batteries.

It is recommended that you place The Philosopher Bass Compressor at the beginning of your signal chain, as close to the bass as possible, before other distortion boxes. This configuration will allow the Philosopher Bass Compressor to drive other pedals down the chain with added sustain, achieving the best possible tone without added noise.

Pigtronix Limited Warranty:

Your Pigtronix effect pedal comes with a 1 year limited warranty on parts and workmanship. During the warranty period we will repair or replace, at our option, defective parts or pedals free of charge, and return them to the owner. Warranty service does not include damaged, modified, or misused pedals and such pedals will be subject to a standard repair charge.
