CARDIOID

POLAR PATTERN

The most common polar pattern. Cardioid captures sound directly from the front of the capsule, whilst offering around 6dB of rejection at the sides with a null point at the rear.

ADVANTAGES:

- Excellent for live sound and full band recordings.
- Minimises risk of capturing reflections in untreated rooms.
