## WARNING!

Do not open cover. No user-serviceable parts inside. Refer servicing to qualified service personnel. Do not place the product in a location near a heat source such as a radiator, or in an area subject to direct sunlight, excessive dust, mechanical vibration or shock. The product must not be exposed to dripping or splashing and no objects filled with liquids, such as vases, shall be placed on the product. No naked flame sources, such as lighted candles, should be placed on the product. Allow adequate air circulation and avoid obstructing vents (if present) to prevent internal heat build-up. The ventilation must not be impeded by covering the appliance with items such as newspapers, table-cloths, curtains etc. The mains plug is used to disconnect the appliance from the mains supply. Ensure that the mains outlet is easily-accessible and remove the plug from the mains outlet if you notice any abnormality with the appliance.

## VAROVÁNÍ!

Neumisťujte produkt v blízkosti zdroje tepla, jako je radiátor, nebo na místo s přímým slunečním světlem, nadměrným prašením, mechanickými vibracemi nebo šokem. Produkt nesmí přijít do kontaktu s vodou a žádné objekty naplněné tekutinami, jako například vázy, by neměly být umístěny na produkt. Žádné zdroje otevřeného ohně, jako například svíčky, by neměly být umístěny na produkt. Umožněte dostatečnou cirkulaci vzduchu a vyhněte se obstrukci ventilátorů (pokud jsou přítomné) pro předěti interního přehřívání. Ventilace nesmí být narušena překrytím zařízení výrobky jako např. noviny, kuchyňské utěrky, záclony apod. Hlavní kabel umožňuje odpojit zařízení od elektriny. Ujistěte se, že hlavní napájecí výstup je snadno dostupný a odpojte kabel pokud zaznamenáte jakoukoliv abnormálnítu na zařízení.

Dækslet må ikke åbnes. Ingen bruger-udskeftelige dele indeni. Overlad service til kvalificeret service personale. Placer ikke produktet i nærheden af varmekilder såsom en radiator eller i direkte sollys, meget støv, mekaniske vibrationer eller stød. Produktet må ikke udsættes for vand eller stænk, og ingen genstande fyldt med væsker, f.eks. vaser, må anbringes på produktet. Må ikke placeres nær åben ild, tændte stearinlys må ikke placeres på produktet. Vær sikker på at der er tilstrækkelig luftcirkulation og undgår at dække ventiler (hvis der er nogen) for at undgå at produktet bliver varmt. ## WAARSCHUWING!

Zorg ervoor dat het stopcontact gemakkelijk bereikbaar is en haal de stekker uit het stopcontact als u enige onregelmatigheden ondervindt.

## VAROITUS!

Älä avaa kantta. Ei sisällä käyttäjä-huollettavia osia. Huollot saa suorittaa vain pätevä huoltomies. Älä säilytä tuotetta minkään kuumen lähellä kuten patteri tai suoraan auringonpaisteesta, pölyisessä, mekaanisessa värinässä tai iskussa. Tuotetta ei saa altistaa tippuvallalle tai loiskeelle tai nesteitä sisältäviä tuotteita kuten maljakkoo eivät saa olla tuotteen lähetyvillä. Avotulia kuten sytytetty kynttilä ei saa olla tuotteen päällä. Salli riittävä ilmankierto ja vältä tuuletusaukkojen tukkiminen (jos sellaisia on olemassa) estämään sisäisen lämmön muodostuminen. Tuulesta ei saa estää peittämällä laite esineillä, kuten sanomalehdillä, pöytäliinoilla, verhoilla jne. Verkkoirtapistoketta käytetään irrottamaan laite verkkovirrasta. Varmista, että pistorasia on helposti saatavilla ja irrota pistotulppa pistorasiasta, jos havaitset jotain epänormaalia laitteessa.
